# Don't waste your energy while you rescue!

Up to now saving people was hard work. Conventional rescuing techniques meant to use up a lot of air, to need a great number of people and much time. Evacuating several persons overstretches the rescuers possibilities and strengths. We, the firemen, couldn't accept these limits and therefore looked out for alternatives and developed the s-2-s. With the help of this bag a group of rescuers can save several persons.



### The s-2-s bag



The s-2-s bag is made of a fire-resistant material. The bottom part is wear and tear proof and guarantees a long life.



It can be rolled up (with Roll-fix) or be stored in its blue bag.



Various accessories facilitate the rescue, e.g. an additional Sling for a third rescuer, in case one has to get up the stairs.

**Simple Handling** In no time the patient is put into the bag and therefore easily rescued.

### Putting in



Velcro fastener  
Easy and quick to handle, particularly when visibility is bad.



Strap-Version  
Patient is easy to be put in particularly when in bed.



Device, personal belongings or even masks can be enclosed.


## Easy Transport



Only one hand is needed. Two persons can move even heavy weighting people. Narrow passages are no problem.



Simple wrapping up; If the patient (even with a breathing mask) is in the bag, the rescue staff can concentrate on his rescue.



Mutual help; a fireman with a breathing apparatus : A fireman completely equipped can be slid down the stairs.




Patients can be moved also in a side position.



The material is extremely heat proof and is suitable to be used as a shield.

## Fixing up Logo / Hang up / Taking along



The pictogram is self-explanatory.



The s-2-s is fixed parallel to the breathing apparatus. Both hands are free.



Easy to carry when rolled up.

To enabling an efficient rescue every group should have a s-2-s.
